Getting downtown from the Salt Lake International Airport

Public transportation

For a Utah-specific experience, you can take the Utah Transit Authority (UTA) TRAX Service. The Airport TRAX station is located on the ground level outside the terminal on the east side. Passengers should exit door 1A and go east. Take the Green Line to Gallivan Plaza Station. Walk west for half a mile to reach the Hilton Salt Lake City Center. One-way fare for the train is \$2.50 USD.

Rideshare

Rideshare services are available in SLC, including Uber and Lyft. Download the app on your phone either through the Apple Store or Google Play Store. You must create your own account to use the app.
